Saw Mill River Audubon is partnering with New York State Parks to offer guided field trips at Rockefeller State Park Preserve. **The cost of your bus transportation, entrance and program fees can all be fully covered by this state grant program.**

Quick & easy online grant application with approval before the field trip. **Field trip topics are customized for your class. Available for grades K through 12.**

Some popular topics include: bird identification and adaptations (Audubon binoculars provided with one pair/student), **plant adaptations** (including seeds, seed dispersal, and classification of plants), **food chains & food webs** (including seasonal wildlife tracks and traces), **forest and aquatic habitats.**
