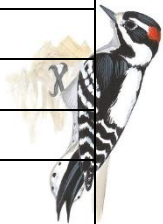
WHEN TO GET YOUR SEED AFTER SEP 2025

Bird Seed Types



Sunflower Seed	All forms of sunflower seed attract most birds. The <i>striped</i> generally has larger seeds. The <i>black oil</i> gives the birds more energy and a more consistent smaller seed and thinner shell. The <i>sunflower coarse chips and hearts</i> leave no hull residue.				
Mixed Seed	As in past years, we are offering our customized <i>SMRA mix</i> . The custom <i>SMRA Economy Mix</i> has fewer sunflower seed to reduce hulls under feeder and higher white millet and corn. The <i>No Mess Mix</i> will leave practically no residue because all hulls are removed. The 2025-2026 seed mix percentages are:				
SMRA Custom Mix	10% striped sunflower 25% black oil sunflower 40% white millet 15% cracked corn 5% safflower 5% whole peanuts	SMRA Economy Mix	10% black oil sunflower 45% white millet 45% cracked corn	No Mess Mix <i>also called Hearty Delight</i>	42% - Sunflower Hearts 15% - Hulled White Millet 35% - Whole Peanuts 3% - Nyjer Thistle 5% - Cracked Corn
White Millet	White Millet is a favorite seed of sparrows, juncos, and doves. We do not use Red Millet in our mixes.				
Thistle (Nyjer)	This is a favorite of goldfinches. A special feeder with small feeding ports or a fine meshed sock is needed.				
Cracked Corn	Attractive for ground feeders like mourning doves, blue jays and sparrows, and squirrels.				
Peanuts	A high energy feed appealing to birds and squirrels.				
Safflower Seed	Noted for <i>not</i> being attractive to squirrels and starlings. Cardinals and chickadees like safflower.				
Suet	Particularly attracts woodpeckers, but also nuthatches, titmice, chickadees, and Carolina Wrens. For this year's sale, we are offering suet mixed with seed.
