

The Saw Mill River Audubon Society.  
Minutes of a Special Meeting of Officers and  
Directors.

A special meeting of Officers and Directors, called by the President, was held at his home 96 Sarles Lane, Pleasantville on Tuesday evening, August 18th, 1953

Those present were Mr. Fennell, Mrs. Overocker, Mr. E. Laire and Mr. Malone.

It had previously been decided that the Society would participate in the Flower Show to be held September 10-11 and 12 under the auspices of the Semens<sup>1</sup> Club of Pleasantville. It was decided to appropriate the sum of \$10.00 for the rental of an Audubon Photographic Tour, which would be used as a background display for our booth at the Show. Afterwards, for an additional fee of \$2.00 we can retain the photographs for display in the Chappaqua and Pleasantville High Schools, Mrs. Laire will arrange a display on tables in the booth of her bird skins and other nature material and various books, cards, stationery etc. with a natural history theme will be on sale. The Secretary was instructed to secure volunteers to staff the booths in two hour periods during the Show,


Mr. Fennell then announced that the Society could secure one of the Audubon Screen Tours for showing on September 21st, We can secure a film and a lecturer for that evening for \$50.00 and after considerable discussion it was decided to put on the Tour and to postpone the regular Fall meeting of the Society until October. It was felt that with an admission fee of \$1.20 for non-members and 60¢ for members and their families it would certainly be possible to cover expenses and probable that some profit would accrue to our treasury.

Mrs. Overocker was delegated to arrange for the Horace Greely High School

auditorium and Mr.Fennell was to start immediate negotiations to secure the Tour for that date.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
