Minutes of a Regular Meeting of  
the Board of Directors and  
Chairmen of Standing Committees

June 2, 1955

The regular meeting of Officers, Directors and Chairmen of Committees, held at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Walton was called to order by the President at 8:45 PM.

Members absent - Mrs. Swope, Mrs. Weinland, Mr. Aikman, Mr. Perkin and Mr. Every.

The Secretary read the minutes of the May 5th meeting which were approved as read.

The Treasurer reported progress with the revised accounting system and a balance as of June 1st, 1955 of \$48.78. The report was approved.

The President announced that the Scholarship Fund had reached the sum of \$578.00, also that Mr. Lethbridge had accepted the Chairmanship of the Field Trip Committee but that the Education, Social, Screen Tour and Research Posts were still unfilled.

Mrs. Walton reported that the Audubon exhibit at the Flower Show would consist of three Diagrams illustrating the aims of conservation efforts, educational literature on all phases of Audubon Interest and a supply of application blanks. Each of the three Societies will have volunteer hosts or hostesses in charge.

Mr. Fennell reported that no answer had yet been received from the Pleasantville High School as to the use of the Library for future Board meetings. Members will be advised of the situation in ample time for the first Fall meeting, September 8.

The President stated that the program for the 1955-56 season was being discussed and some progress was being made in listing speakers and dividing new forms of interest. Power to complete the program was delegated the President and the Chairman of the Beard by unanimous consent.

Mr. Fennell, for the Conservation Committee, reported that progress was being made in the effort to make a Sanctuary of the Bain Turner marsh. The Committee will meet sometime during June.

Mr. Walton requested each officer and Director to try to send the names of three new members of the Membership Committee.

The Publicity Committee was added to the chairman vacancy list when Miss Smith announced her resignation, as she has accepted a position in the West. Upon motion, duly seconded, a unanimous vote of appreciation and thanks for a job well done and best wishes for the future was tendered to Miss Smith.

The Nature Trail, Bulletin, Education and Library Committee Chairmen reported progress. There was no report from the Screen Tour Committee.

There being no further business, a vote of thanks for their gracious hospitality was tendered to Mr. and Mrs. Walton and the meeting adjourned at 10:50.
