Minutes of a Regular Monthly Meeting of Officers, Directors
and Chairmen of Standing Committees. March 1. 1956

The Regular Monthly meeting of the Officers, Directors and Chairmen of Standing Committees of Saw Mill River Audubon Society was held at the Pleasantville High School Cafeteria, at 8:30 P. M. on Thursday, March 1, 1956.

In the absence of the President, Mr. Bowen, the Chairman of the Board, Mr. Fennell, called the meeting to order, and announced that the usual order of business would be dispensed with and that the meeting would be devoted to a discussion of the plans for holding the convention of the Federation of New York State Bird Clubs in this area on May 11-13, 1956. He introduced the guests from Scarsdale and Bedford Audubon Societies and stated that Mr. Jack Wolff, Sr., as chairman of the committee for arrangements would preside for the balance of this meeting.

Mr. Wolff thereupon took the chair.
