October 3, 1957.

The regular meeting of the Directors, Officers and Chairmen of Standing Committees, held at the home of Mrs. Forsythe, was called to order at 8:55 P.M. Owing to a special Field Trip absence of the President and Board Chairman Mrs. Laire, the Vice President presided.

The Minutes of the meeting of Sept. 16, 1957 were read and after a minor correction were approved.

Progress is also being made in the project at Grasslands Hospital which bids fair to be a very valuable asset to the awakening of interest in conservation.

All other committees sent word of active progress.

The next meeting will be held at the home of Mrs. MacDonald, There being no further business, a vote of thanks for her gracious hospitality was tendered to Mrs. Forsythe and the meeting adjourned at 10:10.
