November 6, 1958.

The regular meeting of the Officers, Directors and Chairmen of Standing Committees, held at the home of Mrs. Laire, was called to order at 8:35 P.M.

Members absent- Messers Bowen, Every and Walsh and Mrs. Coggeshall.

The Minutes of the regular meeting of Oct. 2nd were read and approved.

The Treasurer reported as of Oct. 31, a balance in the general fund of \$34.04, In the Scholarship and Education fund \$37.35 and a deficit in the Sanctuary Fund of \$1284 for a total bank balance of \$58.55. We have as a deposit with the National Society a scholarship balance of \$500.00. The Treasurers Report was approved.

The Quaker Meeting House on King St. Chappaqua, bid fair to become a tradition for the site of our Christmas Tea as it has been held there every year since the founding of this Society, but this year we will have to find new quarters as the building is no longer usable. We have been fortunate in obtaining the use of the Parish Hall of All Saints Epis. Church in Briarcliff and the Social Committee will be welcoming us there on Sunday, Dec, 7th at 3 P.M.

The Education Committee reported continued activity and submitted a copy of e letter which Mr. McGuire has prepared to send to the Schools in our territory, a copy of which is attached to these Minutes. The letter received the hearty approval of the Board.

The Conservation Committee and the Sanctuary Section reported active progress. The boundary posting has been very nearly completed. A Field trip to the Sanctuary is planned for members and friends on Sunday, Nov. 16,

The Membership Committee reported the receipt of twelve new memberships and that we are holding the line.

The Publicity Committees' activities are not of a glamorous type but the fruits thereof can be seen, Bill Fennell sees to that and can always report progress.

A vote of thanks to Mrs. Laire for her hospitality brought Business to an end and the meeting adjourned at 10.15 P.M
